

# 2020-2021 Communication Minor

The School of Communication offers a minor in Communication. Students whose majors are within the School of Communication are NOT allowed to pursue a minor within the School of Communication. The minor consists of a minimum of 21 units. Students may enroll in the minor after successfully completing the lower division, prerequisite courses.

## Prerequisites Lower Division Courses

Six units (6) selected from:

- COMM 160 – Argumentation (3)
- COMM 201 – Communication & Community (3)
- COMM 204 – Advanced Public Speaking (3)
- COMM 245 – Interpersonal Communication (3)

Completion of at least 45 units with a minimum overall GPA of 2.75

Completion of the GE oral Communication requirement (COMM 103) with a grade of C or better.

A minimum of six upper division units must be earned at SDSU. This minor is not available to students in the Communication or Health Communication majors.

Six units (6) selected from:
