The Theatre Arts major is an impacted program. To be advanced from pre-major into the Design & Technology major students must complete the following requirements:

- Theatre 240 with a grade of C or higher. This course may not be taken for C/NC
 - Exceptions to the C/NC rule apply only if these courses were taken during Spring 2020, Fall 2020, or Spring 2021, when the TTF Faculty approved temporary use of C/NC for these courses.
- Submit a portfolio of design work at a designated faculty review by the student's junior year. See undergraduate design adviser for details. A transfer student who wishes to qualify for major status may do so at the end of the first semester. A student must provide a letter of support from a previous college or university if no design work is available.

Check for prerequisites before registering for classes. You must have completed the prerequisites for the course for which you are registering, **OR** have completed the equivalent of the prerequisite from another school if you are a transfer student.
