The Theatre Arts major is an impacted program. To be advanced from the pre-major into the Theatre Arts major, students must meet the following requirements:

- THEA 100, 120, 130, and TFM 160 must be completed with a grade of C or higher. These courses may not be taken for credit/no credit (C/NC).
 - Exceptions to the C/NC rule apply only if these courses were taken during Spring 2020, Fall 2020, or Spring 2021, when the TTF Faculty approved temporary use of C/NC for these courses.
- Students need to have a cumulative GPA of 2.4 or higher.

Check for prerequisites before registering for classes. You must have completed the prerequisites for the course you are registering for, or have completed the equivalent of the prerequisite from another school if you are a transfer student.
