

2023-2024 Communication Minor Worksheet

PLEASE NOTE: This advising sheet does not include General Education requirements as outlined in SDSU's General Catalog.

Students minoring in communication learn different ways that communication has been conceptualized and investigated, as well as ways members of the communication discipline have used their knowledge and scholarship to engage a variety of social problems.

To declare the Communication minor, students are required to have:

- Minimum 45 units completed
- Minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA

AND

Completion of the following nine (9) units of coursework with grades of C or better in each class:

- COMM 103 Oral Communication or equivalent (3 units)

Two courses (6 units) selected from these:

- COMM 160 Argumentation (3)
- COMM 201 Communication & Community * (3)
- COMM 204 Advanced Public Speaking * (3)
- COMM 245 Interpersonal Communication (3) - also satisfies GE "Lifelong Learning and Self Development"

* COMM 103 is a prerequisite for this course
